About Crime Stoppers

BACKGROUND

Launched in early 2007 as a program of the Atlanta Police Foundation, Crime Stoppers Atlanta is an anonymous tip line that provides rewards for tips that lead to the arrest and indictment of individuals suspected of committing Part I Felony crimes (Assaults, Fugitives, Homicides, Narcotics, Robbery).

Crime Stoppers works because private reward dollars allow the tipster to remain anonymous. In any investigation, police and other law enforcement agencies encounter individuals who will not directly provide information. The three key reasons are fear of reprisal, an attitude of apathy, and a reluctance to get involved. Crime Stoppers breaks through these barriers by giving people the opportunity to provide information without directly speaking to police or having to testify in court.

Crime Stoppers is a partnership between three essential groups: the community, the media, and law enforcement.

HOW IS THE PROGRAM ADMINISTERED?

Crime Stoppers is administered through a collaborative effort between Atlanta area law enforcement agencies, the community and the media and is governed by the Atlanta Police Foundation.

A civilian Advisory Council makes decisions regarding the amount of the reward and which informants merit reward money. In addition, the Crime Stoppers Law Enforcement Task Force serves in a consultative capacity to make recommendations to the Advisory Council.

Success Story

Annijah Rolax

On July 25, 2007, 9 year old Annijah Rolax was at home on her computer when she was hit by a stray bullet. The gunshot was a result of a violent altercation happening outside of her apartment building. The bullet pierced Annijah's window, striking her in the head, resulting in her death. Through the Crime Stoppers tip line, the community was able to take action in this heinous crime.

On July 26th and 27th, as a result of a tip taken through Crime Stoppers Atlanta, Jason Ardis and Charles West were arrested for the murder of Annijah Rolax.
